Protect your Customers and Employees

Attention business owners: The City of Eureka has passed new policies to protect the public from secondhand smoke by restricting smoking in public places.

The policy affecting Eureka businesses prohibits smoking in outdoor seating and dining areas, and 30 feet from all building entrances, including windows and ventilation.

Business owners are advised to inform all employees and customers of the new smoke-free laws (may use tear-out at bottom of page to distribute with paychecks). Post signs and table tents in areas customers used to smoke.

Things you must do to comply with the new policy:

- 1) Post smoke free/no smoking signs at all building entrances and at least one conspicuous point within the area. (See reverse for posting requirements.)
- 2) Remove any tobacco/cigarette butt receptacles from areas smoking is prohibited.
- 3) Ask Customers who light up to please refrain from smoking within 30 feet of your building entrances, windows and ventilation.



Notice to all employees: In effect August 21, 2010, smoking will be prohibited in all outdoor seating and dining areas, and 30 feet from all building entrances, including windows and building ventilation systems. In order to comply and protect our staff and clients, please politely inform customers to refrain from smoking within 30 feet from all building entrances. Thank you.

Posting of Signs

A Person, Landlord, Employer, or Nonprofit Entity that has legal or actual control of an Enclosed or Unenclosed Area in which Smoking is prohibited by this chapter shall post a clear, conspicuous and unambiguous “No Smoking” or “Smokefree” sign at entrances of every building, and in at least one other conspicuous point within the area. The signs shall have letters of no less than one inch in height and shall include the international “No Smoking” symbol (consisting of a pictorial representation of a burning cigarette enclosed in a red circle with a red bar across it). Signs posted on the exterior of buildings shall include the 30 foot Reasonable Distance requirement (“No-Smoking Within 30-Feet of this Building”). At least one sign with Humboldt County Department of Health and Human Services, Public Health Branch’s phone number [268-2132] where complaints can be directed must be conspicuously posted in each place in which Smoking is prohibited.
